## Graduation Requirements

1. Complete a minimum of 120 college-level credits (1000 and above).
2. Complete at least 40 upper-division credits (3000 and above).
3. Complete at least 30 upper-division credits at DSU for institutional residency.
4. Maximum 12 upper-division transfer credits may fulfill DSU Business program requirements.
5. Cumulative GPA 2.0 or higher.
6. Minimum B- grade in required CIS courses,
7. Minimum C- grade and 2.5 GPA in Business Core Requirements, Core Business Requirement, Finance, and Business Elective courses.
